



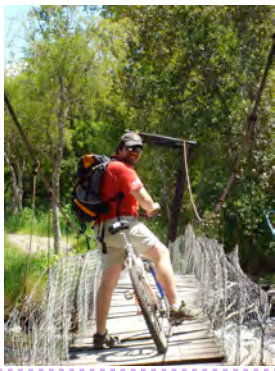

Mountain Biking

One of the best ways to get to know Pucón and its surroundings at your own pace is on a reliable bike with a good map of the region in your hands and some energy to pedal. The area has miles of bike trails for all fitness levels which will take you to the most picturesque corners of this region, reaching waterfalls like the Ojos del Caburgua, beaches at lake Villarrica and Caburgua, hanging bridges over the Trancura River and small forests. Ask for our beautiful informative trail maps!

A light tour, take the main road to Caburgua until you see the "Airport" (aeropuerto) sign. There you will turn left onto a bumpy, gravel road to ride on until you get to the hanging bridge. Cross the bridge, after about 300m, you will turn left again and ride to the end of the road (after crossing two creeks). You will find a beautiful beach where you can enjoy a well-deserved rest and a snack. Please, don't forget to lock up your bike.

10 kilometers / approx. 3 hours

Ojos del Caburgua

Head in the same direction as on the tour to the Delta above. When you pass the hanging bridge, turn to the right and pedal for about 15 minutes until you reach the first steep hill. After that, the road levels off to a soft rolling, hilly terrain until you reach the "Ojos de Caburgua," the waterfalls produced by the end of the Caburgua Lake, and a great picnic spot. Look for a small sign on your right, the entrance is a driveway to a house. After visiting the Ojos, continue on to the main road and turn right to return to Pucón (busy, paved road)m or you can return from Ojos the way you came. If time allows, you can ride on another 7 km to the Lake Caburgua and enjoy yourself at the beach.

17 kilometers / approx. 4 hours
